## 2. KUIS Quick Overview, 2026



- **Overall ranking 8 among all private universities**

KUIS ranked tied for 35th nationwide and 8th among private universities, showing a significant improvement from the previous ranking. In Chiba Prefecture, the university placed 2nd, following National Chiba University.

- **Engagement ranking 3 among all private universities**

In Educational Engagement, KUIS ranked tied for 9th nationwide and 3rd among private universities.

The university also placed 2nd among private universities in eastern Japan and has maintained the top position in Chiba Prefecture since the ranking began.

- **Environment ranking 1 in Chiba Prefecture**

In the International Outlook ranking, which measures the extent of a university's global learning environment, KUIS placed 18th nationwide. Within Chiba Prefecture, the university ranked 1st among all universities, including national, public, and private institutions.

It is open to students of all Japanese proficiency levels. Those who meet the language requirements may also take regular university courses offered by the Faculty of Foreign Languages or the Faculty of Global Liberal Arts alongside Japanese students. *</p> <p>*Refer to the application guide for the language requirements.</p>	<p>Program 2: Undergraduate Courses in English</p> <p>This program focuses on courses taught in English offered by the Faculty of Foreign Languages or the Faculty of Global Liberal Arts.* It is particularly well-suited for students who wish to deepen their understanding of Japan, as it offers a wide range of courses in Japan studies.</p> <p>*Refer to the application guide for the language requirements.</p>

## 4. Application



### Application

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Applicants must be students from partner institutions of KUIS.</li> <li>- Applicants must be nominated as exchange students or fee-paying students by their home institutions.</li> <li>- Applicants must have completed at least 12 years of formal schooling. If not, applicants must be 18 years old or older at the start of the program and have passed an examination which proves that applicants have attained the same or higher academic level as 12 years of formal schooling at the time of application.</li> <li>- Applicants must maintain their enrollment status at their home institutions throughout the duration of the exchange program.</li> <li>- Applicants must have completed at least one year of study at their home institutions by the time of studying at KUIS.</li> </ul> <p>*Other details can be found in the “Application Guide”.</p>
GPA Requirement	<p>None unless stated in the agreement. Home university’s nomination is required.</p> <p>The home university must ensure that the student has an excellent academic performance, is of good character and complies with the law and regulations in Japan and at KUIS, as well as conducts themselves properly.</p>

Period	<p>1 or 2 semesters.</p> <p>Applicants must choose a program at the time of application.</p> <p>*Changing the period (1 semester to 2, or 2 semesters to 1) cannot be accepted without legitimate reasons, regardless of whether your home institution approves your request or not.</p> <p>*Students must leave Japan within two weeks after the last day of the semester at the end of each semester in accordance with the Immigration Services Agency’s regulations.</p>
Visa	<p>Exchange students—except for those who are Japanese nationals or hold Permanent Resident or Long-term Resident status—must obtain a Student Visa before entering Japan.</p>



## 5. Fees, Expenses, and Housing



### Fees and Expenses

Rent	Approx. JPY 300,000 – 450,000 / semester *Including Electricity, Gas, Water, Internet	+initial fee (approx. ¥70,000-150,000)
Meals	Approx. JPY 40,000/month	Dormitories and apartments are self-catering
Textbooks	Approx. JPY 7,000 - 20,000/semester	
Insurance (mandatory)	Approx. JPY 20,000/semester	National Health Insurance and Inbound Insurance

### Housing

Exchange and fee-paying students can stay in an off-campus dormitory or an apartment managed by an affiliated company. Students may apply for their preferred housing option; however, their choice is not guaranteed, and housing is not assured for every student.

Details will be provided for accepted students. In principle, the rent for the semester has to be paid at one time. Room sharing is not allowed. Students must comply with the rules and regulations of the apartment.

## 6. Student Support



### Scholarship

I. Living Support Scholarship	Stipend: 30,000 yen/month For students from partner universities in Indonesia, Vietnam, Thailand, Malaysia, Mexico, Brazil, Argentina or Paraguay.
II. Exchange Activity Scholarship	Stipend: 20,000 yen/month For students whose mother language is Chinese, Korean, Indonesian, Vietnamese, Thai, Spanish or Portuguese. Applicants will be screened and must be selected to perform on-campus duties.

### Volunteer students

Welcome Team	On a designated move-in date, a student volunteer group called “Welcome Team” will take exchange students to their accommodation.
Kaedemates	Kaedemates (Program 1 only) are student peers, who are interested in multicultural communication. Exchange students meet them once a week to improve their language skills.
KUIS Global Ambassadors (KGA)	KUIS Global Ambassadors (KGA) is a student group who plans and holds various interaction events such as day trips and mini-game competitions.
