The speaker

Tom Cech was born and raised on a farm near Clarkson, Nebraska, graduated from Kearney State College with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Math Education, and later

received a Masters Degree in Community and Regional Planning from the University of Nebraska – Lincoln. He was Executive Director of the Central Colorado Water Conservancy District in Greeley, taught water undergraduate and graduate level water resources courses at the University of Northern Colorado and Colorado State University, and is the former Director of the One World One Water (OWOW) Center for Urban Water Education and Stewardship at MSU Denver. He is the author of the world wide famous book "Principles of Water Resources: History, Development, Management, and Policy".
